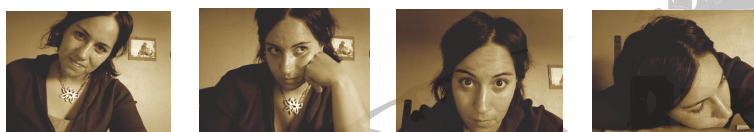


## TRACY HOWE / THE RESTORATION PROJECT
